

Applicable Laws for Auditors'


The auditing profession was formally reorganized in the UAE under following law and regulations:

- Federal Law No (12) of 2014
- Cabinet Resolution No (21) of 2016
- Federal Decree Law No (14) of 2019
- Cabinet Decision No. 48/2022 on the Implementing Regulation of Federal Law No. 12/2014 on the Regulation of the Auditing Profession









Ministerial Resolution No. 43 of 2015 Concerning the International Standards of the Auditing Profession set out the auditor standards to be met.

Resolution requires an auditor to implement:

- 1. International Accounting Standards (IAS)
- International accounting standards (IAS) [issued by the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB)]
- Behavior and Ethics of the Profession (IES)
- Behavior and ethics of the profession (IES) [issued by the International Ethics Standard Board for Accountants (IESBA)]
- 3. International Audit Quality Standards (ISA)
- International audit quality standards (ISA) [issued by the International Accounting and Assurance Standard Board (IAASB)]
- Standard (IFRS)

Conditions for registration in the register of practicing physical auditors (Article 4)

To Register as the Physical Auditor must be:

- Fully Qualified
- Holding a Valid Identity Card
- ❖ Good Conduct and Behavior Certificate
- ❖ Bachelor's degree providing the person has the equivalent of at least (15) fifteen hours of study in accounting courses
- ❖ Valid Fellowship Certificate
- ❖ Having practical experience in auditing for a period of no less than (5) five years since obtaining the academic qualification

Detailed meaning of 5 Years Practical Experience

One year if the person's experience outside the UAE exceeds (10) ten years

Two years if the person's experience outside the UAE is from (5) five to (10) ten years

Three years if the person's experience outside the UAE is from two to (5) five years.

- Authenticity letter of University Degree from Indian Consulate via VFS
- Letter from University that University was affiliated during the period of study (Some Time)





Fines and crimes for Auditors

The Ministerial Resolution No 633 of 2016 Concerning the Regulation and Procedures of Reconciliation of the Crimes Committed by Auditors sets out the crimes and penalties applicable to auditors.

Detail Of The Crime Defined	Penalty
Auditor's name is not accompanied by a registration number in all printed materials, correspondences, certifications and reports	AED 20,000
Auditor does not display certificate in a prominent location at his office	AED 20,000
Auditor's name is not used as a basic element in the address of the firm	AED 80,000
Auditor fails to verify the truth and correctness of auditor's report	AED 80,000
Failure to comply to the rules of behavior and ethics - International standards	AED 60,000
Auditor fails to keep the records for a period of not less than 5 years	AED 50,000
Auditor fails to provide any information asked for by the Minister about the companies whose accounts, he/she had audited	AED 60,000
